Saturday, January 1

Ther.: 24+

Wea.: Cold and windy

Bought a load of wood and chopped it all up this afternoon. The wind was furious and cold, and I felt as cold as ever last winter. Had a letter from Kate tonight.

Sunday, Jan. 2 Ther.: 19+ Wea.: cold

Last night the coldest of season so far. I attended the Episcopal church this forenoon, 16 others there. Went out to Mr. Howes for dinner. We did a little singing afterward.

Monday, Jan. 3 Ther.: 30+

It has moderated. I printed up and finished all but burnishing a lot of views. Took another view of Tryon this forenoon. Developed tonight.

Tuesday, Jan. 4 Ther.: 50+

Been warm and pleasant all day. Clouding a little tonight. I took some views over and showed them to mr. Godshaw. Left some at the drug store. Went over to the Pacolet valley this afternoon a little while. Took a portrait this afternoon.

Wednesday, Jan. 5 Ther.: 63+

Wea.: fine

This morning I went out and took a baby's picture, then I went down and got a view of the high trestle on the Railway. This afternoon I went out to Lyn and was taken through the knitting factory there. Been a warm day.

Thursday, Jan. 6 Wea.: rainy

It rained about all day. I wrote an order for some Photo Goods. Marked some negatives and wrote a letter to Kate. Had a letter from Hiram and they had a freeze there last week.

Friday, Jan. 7

Wea.: clear, moderate

I went out viewing this forenoon, taking two views of the Knitting Mill at Lyn. Had a letter from Mr. Jacobs at noon telling me to go ahead with the views, so I will close up here soon. Did some printing this afternoon.

Saturday, Jan. 8 Ther.: 64+ Wea.: warm, fine I worked today at finishing up a batch of photos. Had another letter from Jenks hurrying me up about the mining views they want. Sold some more of my etchings to an artist, who spends her winters here.

Sunday, Jan. 9 Wea.: warm, cloudy

Did not go to church today as I had so much writing to do in connection with my going away. Called out in the Pacolet valley this afternoon.

Monday, Jan. 10 Ther.: 70+ Wea.: warm

Have been very busy all day packing up to leave tomorrow. It has been so warm that I did not need any fire. Sent off for a lot of photo goods. Had a nice lot of etchings from Kate tonight. Packed my trunk tonight.

Tuesday, Jan. 11 Wea.: rain

After I got ready to leave this morning it began raining. Left Tryon on the noon train. Stopped 2 hours in Hendersonville and then came to Brevard, where I am staying tonight.

Wednesday, Jan. 12

Mr. Hays came down with his team last night, and I drove them back for him today, so was very lucky. It has been a good day but is raining tonight. Am at Sapphire again.

Thursday, Jan. 13 Wea.: Cooler and clear

Mr. Burlingame took me all about the line on my land this forenoon, and I am well pleased with it. I picked out a place for house site and cleaned off a little of the ground this afternoon. Staying with Lowry Verner tonight.

Friday, Jan. 14 Wea.: clouds

I looked about on my place this forenoon. Found some very pretty spots, and one beautiful little glen. Cleaned out a couple of springs. Had letters from home tonight.

Saturday, Jan. 15 Wea.: rain

This forenoon it rained about all the time. I rode Mr. Burlingame's horse over to his place and took his dinner. Worked a cleaning a road out on my place. Took Mr. B. and Lucy over to see my Glen.

Sunday, Jan. 16 Wea.: Clear

I went to the Sapphire Sunday School this forenoon then took Lowry Verner over to see my place, then went up to Mr. R. A. Jacobs with him to dinner. Went to hotel to a sing this evening.

Monday, Jan. 17 Wea.: rain

It has been a cloudy, chilly, disagreeable day. We all expected snow. I chopped up some wood this forenoon. Mr. B. and I sent an order for fruit trees. Wrote a letter to Kate tonight.

Tuesday, Jan. 18

The weather continues raw and chilly. I made a ground glass for my camera this forenoon. Went over to "Kate's Glen" this afternoon with Mrs. B., Miss Stolzenback and Mr. Geo. Jacobs.

Wednesday, Jan. 19 Wea.: rain and sleet

It has stormed all day, raining and sleeting. I went with Mr. Burlingame and helped him put on lathe in his house. I am getting anxious to go to Highlands as my mail must be going there now.

Thursday, Jan. 20 Wea.: clear and warmer

This has been a beautiful day. I went up on Mt. Toxaway this forenoon and made views of the Club House. This afternoon I did some viewing for Mr. Jenks, with my large camera which came today.

Friday, Jan. 21 Wea.: Fine

Mr. Crisp's team took me and my things to Highlands today. I walked considerable and had a fine chance to use my field glass. Am going to stay at Mr. Rideouts while here.

Saturday, Jan. 22 Wea.: rain

Spent the day in getting my things in shape for photo work. Have a room in back of house for developing and developed 3 8 x 10's tonight. Had a letter from Kate this evening. It is warmer and rains hard tonight.

Sunday, Jan. 23 Wea.: cool, pleasant

Went to church this forenoon and heard Mr. Wade preach. This afternoon the team came from Cullasajee and took me and camera down the mountain to that point where I am to begin my job of viewing.

Monday, Jan. 24 Wea.: pleasant

Have been hard at work all day making views at Corundum Hill. Exposed 17 plates. Called and took supper at Mr. Geo. Jacobs tonight. Am tired.

Tuesday, Jan. 25 Wea.: rain

It rained hard during last night. Went to the Elijay mines to make views. It rained quite hard before we got back. I had a letter from ma and a p.o. order for \$60 in it. Called at Geo. Jacobs.

Wednesday, Jan. 26 Wea.: Cool, clear

Took a view of Mr. Geo. Jacobs house this morning and also the original Cullasaja apple tree. Viewed a Corundum mine on top of a mountain and a man's house in the valley. It is much colder.

Thursday, Jan. 27 Wea.: bright

I started with two wagons this morning and went to the Corundum mines at Buck Creek over the Nantahala mountains into Clay Co. We camp in a log cabin. Had a nice trip.

Friday, Jan. 28 Wea.: bright

Spent today in making views on the mining property. I like the country up here very much and Buck Creek is the prettiest stream I about ever saw. I get very hungry and eat hearty.

Saturday, Jan. 29 Wea.: clear

We came back to Cullasaja today. Camped for dinner just this side of the Nantahala's. We also stopped and had supper, then drove in by moonlight. I have enjoyed this trip. Found two letters here from Kate.

Sunday, Jan. 30 Wea.: cold, snow

This morning it was snowing and was much like winter. I took dinner with the Jacobs and spent most of the afternoon there. Wrote to Kate this evening.

Monday, Jan. 31 Wea.: cold

It was cold and blustering today, with snow flurries this forenoon. I took some views and then climbed a mountain to get a sight of Franklin.

Tuesday, February 1 Ther.: 6+ Wea.: cold

It has been a cold day. I walked up to Highlands. It was snowy on top of the mountains and hard walking. Took supper and spent the evening at Mr. Bascom's. Very cold tonight.

Wednesday, Feb. 2 Wea.: cold

Wrote some letters this forenoon and sent \$30 to Mr. Burlingame to pay on my little house. It is real cold and some stormy tonight. Cannot do any photo work.

Thursday, Feb. 3 Ther.: 0 Wea.: cold

It was the coldest of the season this morning. Have done nothing today but loaf about. Wrote a letter to Kate. Called at the Higlands House this evening.

Friday, Feb. 4

Not quite so cold this morning. The Cullasaja team came for me this afternoon and took me to Laurel Creek, Ga. I am staying at a typical mountain house. Cook by the fireplace, all sleep in the same room.

Saturday, Feb. 5 Wea.: snow Started out this morning to make views but only got two when it began to snow. Came back to Highlands and began fixing up the dark room. Developed some.

Sunday, Feb. 6 Wea.: bright

Went to church this forenoon. It is thawing in the sunlight. Am hoping for good weather to work at my picture business. Wrote a letter to ma and one to Hiram Glover.

Monday, Feb. 7 Wea.: Fair, warmer

Have been at the developing all day. It was a cold job this forenoon and I had to keep warming the developer all day. Had a letter from Kate tonight.

Tuesday, Feb. 8 Wea.: fair

Spent all day and late this evening developing. Have 12 more exposed plates. Mrs. Rideout is sick with the Grippe. I seems to get a little warmer each day.

Wednesday, Feb. 9 Wea.: mild

I began labeling the negatives this forenoon. This afternoon I finished developing all exposed plates. It has been a comfortable day to work.

Thursday, Feb. 10 Wea.: mild

I finished marking what negatives I have on hand this forenoon. This afternoon I walked down to Pine Mountain, Georgia to be ready to make views tomorrow.

Friday, Feb. 11 Wea.: warm, cloudy

This has not been a fair day, for the clouds and smoke but, I made what exposures I needed and walked back to Highlands this afternoon. Went to a sing tonight.

Saturday, Feb. 12 Wea.: bright and warm

Been at work all day and till 10:30 tonight. Printed and finished a batch of photos, and developed some plates. It has been a lovely day. Heard that I won 2nd prize on my views at the exhibition at Jackson, Mich, P.A. of Mich.

Sunday, Feb. 13 Wea.: mild and bright.

Went to church this forenoon. Wrote several letters this afternoon and also took a walk about the lake and called on Dr. Anderson.

Monday, Feb. 14 Wea.: mild and bright.

Printed photos about all day. Developed the last of the Ga. Views this evening. Had a letter from Kate tonight.

Tuesday, Feb. 15 Wea.: cold

It has turned colder tonight. I finished a batch of views and did up a package of 53 to send to Mr. Jenks in the morning.

Wednesday, Feb. 16

Ther.: 16+ Wea.: cold

Been printing views all day long. Mr. Blaine from Cullasaja called and brought my Mcintoch coat. They want me to come back down there again.

Thursday, Feb. 17

Tried printing this forenoon but it soon got so cloudy that at noon I quite. Tonight it rains. Tried a fancy photo of Miss Elsie. Sang songs tonight.

Friday, Feb. 18

It rained hard all last night. I could do no work this forenoon, but printed this afternoon. Went to choir practice at Mr. White's tonight.

17 days at Rideouts.

Saturday, Feb. 19

Foggy all day so I could not print. Went up to Mr. Walden's this forenoon and had my hair cut. Took several portrait negatives this afternoon. Young people had a candy ball[?] here this evening.

Sunday, Feb. 20

It stormed some this forenoon, but was clear and pleasant this afternoon turning colder tonight. I went up on Satulah Mt. and took my field glass. Fine views.

Monday, Feb. 21 Ther.: 14+ Wea.: cold

Snow on the ground this morning and cold windy weather all day. I did a half days printing, but it was disagreeable work.

Tuesday, Feb. 22 Ther.: 11+ Wea.: cold

Printed all day and almost finished from the mine negatives. I also did some retouching and portrait printing. Don't feel very well but hope I can escape the prevailing cold.

Wednesday, Feb. 23 Wea.: milder

Took a walk out toward Shortoff this forenoon. This afternoon I finished up a small batch of portraits, etc. Feel better than last night.

Thursday, Feb. 24

Wea.: cool, windy

Worked all day finishing on the mine views. Had a hard toothache last night and don't suppose cold water soaking will help it any.

Friday, Feb. 25 Ther.: 31+ Wea.: pleasant

Toned and finished 54 8 x 10 views today. The wind blows but the latter part of the day was pleasant. This morning it snowed. Am going to the singing practice tonight at Mr. Cobb's.

Saturday, Feb. 26 Wea.: snow

Finished the last batch of the mine views today and have them done up ready to box tonight. We had quite a snow storm this afternoon, but it is mild weather.

Sunday, Feb. 27

The snow went off today. Went to church this forenoon. Wrote some letters and called on Mr. Manley this afternoon and looked his place over.

Monday, Feb. 28

I packed up the mine views and negatives for shipping. Looked over all the Highlands views at Miss White's and made out a list to print. She is going away for a while.

Tuesday, March 1

Prined some photos this forenoon and also went up on Satulah Mt. This afternoon I took my camera and made 3 stereoscopic views going out as far as Highland Falls.

Wednesday, March 2

Wea.: rain

Finished up some photos and calendars today. I rained about all day. Wrote letters to Kate and Hiram Glover. Developed the Stereo plates this evening.

Thursday, March 3 Wea.: cloudy

Been about sick with a cold all day, but went up on Satulah mountain to take some Stereo views this forenoon. Kept in the house all the afternoon.

Friday, March 4 Wea.: clouds

Stayed in and doctored my cold most of the day. Tried taking a few portraits this afternoon. Felt too sore in my throat to go to the sing tonight.

Saturday, March 5 Wea.: bright

Went up on Bear Pen Mt. this morning and made an exposure of one Stereo plate. Printed a lot of photos for Mrs. Bascom. Developed some plates this afternoon.

Sunday, March 6 Wea.: bright

Did not go to church today on account of my hard cold. I took a walk this afternoon over to the cemetery, and on a new road down to Pinkertons Pool.

Monday, March 7 Wea.: bright, milder

I did some retouching and printing this forenoon. This afternoon I finished a batch of photos and made couple more portrait exposures.

Tuesday, March 8 Wea.: bright

Mr. Rideout went with me to a pretty fall on the Cullasagee river this forenoon. This afternoon I went out and called on the Cobb family. Developed plates tonight.

Wednesday, March 9 Wea.: bright

Got ready this morning and came through on foot to Sapphire. Called at Col. Alley's in Whiteside Cove. Got here about 4 o'clock.

Thursday, March 10 Wea.: warm, clear

Worked this forenoon chopping down dead trees. This afternoon marked out the ground and began setting fruit trees. Mr. Dave Miller helped me all day.

Friday, March 11 Wea.: warm, foggy

Worked hard all day putting out trees. Mr. Arthur Miller began to build my little house. Mr. Dave M. helping him. I am very tired tonight.

Saturday, March 12 Wea.: warm, foggy

I finished setting out my fruit trees and vines today and got them all trimed and a plat made so I cane locate them all. It threatened all the time to rain but has not yet.

Sunday, March 13 Wea.: rain

I walked back to Highlands today and had a rainy time of it but was glad to get back. Found a check from Hampden Co., for \$65. 69, also a letter from Kate.

Monday, March 14 Wea.: Rain

It stormed more or less, and I was lucky to have come back yesterday. I let Mr. Bascom have my check and took a due bill. Let Miss Elsie take my guitar to play on.

Tuesday, March 15

Wea.: misty

I fixed up a salting batch and salted 61 8 x 10 pieces of plain paper today. The air is so damp it doesn't dry fast at all. News of approaching war with Spain seem to grow stranger.

Wednesday, March 16

Wea.: foggy

Salted more paper this forenoon. This afternoon I went up Satulah Mt. above the clouds, but could not get a good photo. Had a letter from Kate tonight.

Thursday, March 17

Wea.: warm

Retouched couple of negatives this morning. It cleared up about noon and after dinner I took my camera and went to Cullasaja falls and Cullacaleski falls after views. It was very warm walking. Developed the plates tonight.

Friday, March 18

Wea.: warm

It has been foggy most all day, so I got nothing done. It cleared up just before night. Had a letter from Vida and one from Hiram Glover.

Saturday, March 19

Ther.: 72+ Wea.: warm

I went to Glen Falls this forenoon and made an 8 x 10 view. This afternoon I fixed up some paper and made some blue prints. It has been a pleasant day.

Sunday, March 20

Ther.: 72+ Wea.: warm

Went to church this forenoon and sang in the choir. This afternoon I took a walk up Satulah Mt. to a place called the "Sea of Views." Been a warm day.

Monday, March 21

Wea.: warm

I did some printing this forenoon. This afternoon I went to Pinkertons Pool for Stereo views. Took an interior for Mr. White's folks. Warm, hazy weather.

Tuesday, March 22

Wea.: warm

I had Mr. Ravenel's riding horse today and went with Mr. Wright down the Cullasaja river to get some views. There is fine scenery down there. It was a good day for us.

Wednesday, March 23

Wea.: warm

I did some printing this forenoon, and also made a few small blue prints. This afternoon I went down the Walhala road several miles to get a view of Satulah Mt.

Thursday, March 24

Wea.: cooler

Took a photo of a store this morning and then went at printing, but at noon there came a rain and stopped me, so I finished a batch this afternoon. It has stopped raining tonight.

Friday, March 25 Wea.: cool

I went up on Satulah this morning and tried to get a panoramic view then I went on Bear Pen and took a view of Highlands from there. The air was quite clear.

Saturday, March 26

Wea.: mild

Printed up a set of views ordered by Mr. Symington. Also got a few prints from negatives made yesterday. Developed more plates tonight and sensitized lot more paper for blue prints.

Sunday, March 27

Wea.: rain

It has been cloudy and rainy all day. I did not go to church as I had a bad headache. Took a nap after dinner and felt better.

Monday, March 28

Wea.: rain

It has rained hard all day. I finished up a batch of photos and fixed up the Syminton work. Had a letter from Ma and Kate tonight.

Tuesday, March 29

Wea.: rain

I mailed Mr. Symington his views this morning, then I got ready and walked to Sapphire. It rained very hard last night, and the water was so high I had to take the main road. It rained quite hard today also.

Wednesday, March 30

Wea.: misty

This forenoon I went to Dave Miller's and got him to go with me over my place to show him what I wished down. Saw my little house. Went to the Co.'s office and got an order for views form Mr. Hays. It began to clear up this evening.

Thursday, March 31 Wea.: clear, cool

There was frost and some ice this morning. I walked back to Highlands this forenoon, and this afternoon I printed views and made a lot of Blue prints. It is cool.

Friday, April 1 Wea.: cool

This was Kate's birthday. I finished up some photos and then began packing up my negatives and tools. Hope to start for home next Monday.

Saturday, April 2 Wea.: chilly Worked hard all day packing up my tools and goods, and partly packed my trunk tonight. Insured my Sapphire house with Mr. White for Seventy-five Dollars. Felt tired tonight.

Sunday, April 3

I wrote 12 letters today and it made me tired. Finished packing my trunk. Called on Mrs. Davis this afternoon. It looks stormy tonight.

Monday, April 4

Got up at 5 o'clock this morning and made some coffee and oats. Left at 6 o'clock with the wagon and rode to Walhalla, where I got a livery and went to Westminster where I took the train and came to Atlanta. It rains hard.

Tuesday, April 5

Got up early this morning but the train was late and kept on getting late all day so missed connection at Cincinnati and have to stay all night. There was snow in Kentucky.

Wednesday, April 6

Came through Ohio today. Plenty of signs of the flood in the Miama valley. Had supper in Detroit and came to Delhi about 10 o'clock. Will was there to meet me.

Thursday, April 7

Got my trunk over from Delhi today and unpacked it. It freezes nights and is very cool and March like. Been looking at pictures and books good deal.

Friday, April 8

I wrote some letters and sent some orders for Photo stock. Went up to Dexter this afternoon. Went to the sing at the church tonight.

Saturday, April 9

Helped pa and Willie in cleaning up for the new barn site during the forenoon. Geo. Martin was here at dinner. Willie and I made some berry crates this afternoon.

Sunday, April 10

Went to church this forenoon and sang in the home choir once more. They had Easter exercises. It threatened rain, but has cleared off this evening. Went to church tonight.

Monday, April 11

Helped do the washing this morning and then Kate and I went to Ann Arbor. I got some stuff for my photo work. It has been warmer and a very pleasant day.

Tuesday, April 12 Wea.: warmer

I worked today at salting plain paper. I made a board for holding it when I sensitize and fixed a few sheets tonight to print tomorrow. Been getting warm.

Wednesday, April 13

Wea.: dry

Found I had made a mistake fixing my paper, so had to go to Ann Arbor again for more things. Went on train and walked home. Vida had telegram that her father was dead.

Thursday, April 14

Salted paper this forenoon. Went to Dexter this afternoon and got freight from Philadelphia. It was a windy and dusty ride. It is very dry. Pa began digging for his new barn cellar.

Friday, April 15

I made up a large batch of photo Etchings today, and silvered paper for tomorrow's work this evening. Ma and Vida went to a reading at the M. E. Church.

Saturday, April 16

It was not very clear today and bothered me about printing, but I got a batch done. Pa and I burned a march tonight. We had a fruit ice when we got all done work.

Sunday, April 17

It has been a pleasant day but turned cool this evening. I did not go to church today. Kate and I drove over to her folkses this afternoon. Thunders tonight.

Monday, April 18

There was some rain last night and it has sprinkled and spit hail during today. Made a cupboard for my negatives. Vida and I went to Dexter this afternoon. It is very cool.

Tuesday, April 19

Wea.: cool

It has been a rainy day. I spent the forenoon in putting up some new window shades. We heard this evening that war with Spain had been declared.

Wednesday, April 20 Wea.: cool, misty

I printed and finished a batch of photo-etchings, mounting most of them. Got through in time to help Willie draw up some wood, we burn a good deal this weather.

Thursday, April 21 Wea.: warmer

I made another batch of pictures today. It was sunny and pleasant. Pa went to an auction and bought a horse.

Friday, April 22 Wea.: rain

I went to Ann Arbor this forenoon to take photos I have made for Mr. Hays to get them bound in books. Lizzie and Marion came home with me. It was rather a rainy trip.

Saturday, April 23 Wea.: Cloudy I mowed the lawn today. Went to Dexter this forenoon. Pa hitched up his new colt this evening. I spread some straw in the field.

Sunday, April 24 Wea.: cool

Took Kate out for a short ride this forenoon. Did not go to church. Pa and Horace Sayles went to Dexter this afternoon. They got some more war news.

Monday, April 25 Wea.: Cool and damp

It rained some today. Helped wash this morning, then signed up a lot of photos. Don was here to dinner. I dug about some peach trees and put ashes around them.

Tuesday, April 26 Wea.: warmer

Printed a lot of Blue Prints but spoiled most of them. Went up to Dexter this afternoon with Ossian Kenny. There was no important war news.

Wednesday, April 27

Wea.: warm

I took Lizzie and the baby back to Ann Arbor this morning, did some errands, and got home at noon. Helped draw gravel and stone this afternoon.

Thursday, April 28

Wea.: clear

Went to Dexter this forenoon and sent pictures by express to Sapphire. I carried hod for the stone mason this afternoon. It rains some this evening.

Friday, April 29 Wea.: pleasant

I went to Ann Arbor on the train at noon and bought a kodak for Prof. Harvey. Walked home and took views with it to test by. Developed them tonight. Pa and Ma went to Dexter.

Saturday, April 30

Wea.: clear

Helped Willie draw stone this forenoon. Pa went away and traded horses. Mowed the lawn this afternoon. Got pretty tired.

Sunday, May 1 Wea.: warm

Took a nap this forenoon and loafed generously all day. A good many teams and wheels went out to Island Lake where the soldiers are camping. It has showered several times.

Monday, May 2 Wea.: warm

Helped wash this morning and then I sprayed the gooseberry bushes and some currants and some grape vines. This afternoon I went to Dexter and expressed the little camera to Mr. Harvey. All excitement over the war.

Tuesday, May 3 Wea.: cool

Pa and I went to Delhi this morning for the carpenters tools, then we drew a little wood and went to drawing stone for the barn wall. Split some wood this afternoon.

Wednesday, May 4 Wea.: cool

Helped pa start plowing for corn. Helped Will draw stone, spread manure. Put some ashes about the plum trees. Kate printed photos for me and I trimed them tonight.

Thursday, May 5 Wea.: cool, rain

Went down to Wheeler's this forenoon with Willie to saw out some strips for his crates. It rained a good share of the day. Kate began finishing the photos and I completed the job this afernoon and evening.

Friday, May 6 Wea.: frost

I spread straw this forenoon. Put ashes around the pear trees. Went to Ann Arbor this afternoon and came back on the evening train. Stopped at the parsonage and got a dish of sherbet.

Saturday, May 7 Wea.: warmer

Spread straw and sharpened the lawn mower this forenoon. Mowed the lawn this afternoon and hunted steel buttes off the grape vines.

Sunday, May 8 Wea.: warm

Kate and I went over to her folks and took dinner today. Don went to Dexter and got the official news of Dewey's victory at the Phillipine Islands over the Spanish fleet and forts.

Monday, May 9 Wea.: fine

Got up about 3 o'clock this morning and did some tall riding on Will's wheel. At 5:10 a boy was born and we named him Philip Dewey Scadin. Carpenters began work on the barn today.

Tuesday, May 10 Wea.: Rain

It rained about all the forenoon. I went to Dexter this afternoon to mail letters and do errands. Kate and baby seem to be doing well. I receive many congratulations.

Wednesday, May 11 Wea.: Fine

The baby has been sick today and we are worried about him. Drew stone, split wood and did various jobs. Worked in the garden some hoeing and planting peas.

Thursday, May 12

Wea.: Fine

Monday, May 16 Wea.: Warm

Helped Willie draw stone this forenoon. Planted some sweet corn, hoed in the garden, hunted bugs off grape vines, sprayed gooseberry bushes, and did chores this afternoon. It continues very dry.

Tuesday, May 17

Mixed up Bordeaux and paris green and sprayed the plum trees this morning, also sprayed some currant and gooseberry bushes. Kate and "Dewey" seem to be doing well.

Wednesday, May 18 Wea.: Shower

Worked at spraying some this morning, then helped saw and work on getting barn timbers in shape. Had to go to Dexter this afternoon to get harness mended.

Thursday, May 19 Wea.: Showers

Had to go to Dexter again this morning. Then I drew stone for the masons. This afternoon I worked with the choppers scoring timber in the woods. It has been a warm day with a little rain.

Friday, May 20

We had a heavy rain last night which soaked up the ground good. Mowed the lawn and helped haul timbers. Kate sat up in a chair today. This building is hard work.

Saturday, May 21 Wea.: Rain

The carpenters went home this morning for a few days stay. There came up a big rain that stopped the masons again. Nettie West came up from Ann Arbor.

Sunday, May 22 Wea.: Fine

Mrs. Case went home for a short visit today and Kate and I with Ma's help took care of the baby. He was not real well. Mr. and Mrs. Ben Sutherland called. It sprinkles again tonight.

Monday, May 23 Wea.: fine

We had a shower early this morning and then it cleared up. I helped draw logs to the saw mill today, and also did some spraying on fruit trees.

Tuesday, May 24 Wea.: fine

Hoed in the garden and helped draw stone this forenoon. Mrs. Case brought the baby out in the dining room at noon. Will and I planted melons this afternoon.

Wednesday, May 25 Wea.: Fine

I went to Ann Arbor with Mr. Sharpy this forenoon to get him help on the barn wall. He hired a darky. The carpenters came again today.

Thursday, May 26 Wea.: Fine

Been working at hauling logs and lumber about all day. I went to Delhi for flour this morning. It was about 8 o'clock when I got my supper tonight.

Friday, May 27 Wea.: Fine

Dug some in trench on barn wall this morning, then took wheel and went to Wheelers and will Burnett's. Mowed lawn this afternoon. Had a letter from Mr. Hays with check.

Saturday, May 28 Wea.: Showers

The masons finished the wall this forenoon. Pa went to Hamburg and brought aunt Eliza Whitmore home with him. We had a hard days work getting a 40 foot beam out of the woods. A hard shower at noon.

Sunday, May 29 Wea.: fine

I took the nurse who has had care of Kate and baby home today. We will have to get along best we can alone now. It has been cooler than usual today.

Monday, May 30 Wea.: very fine

This has been one of the most beautiful days of this spring. We had a bee and drew a carload of lumber up from Delhi. I have my fingers sore from handling lumber and stone.

Tuesday, May 31

Pa was very sick last night with congestion of the lungs. He became easier today. I went to Lew Bennetts raising this forenoon and rode the wheel about giving invitations to our raising this afternoon.

Wednesday, June 1

We have been getting ready for our raising. I went to Dexter this evening for the things cooked at the bakers. Pa has been getting better.

Thursday, June 2 Wea.: Warm

We had the barn raising today. There was about 150 people here. We did not get quite through. Pa was out some to see. It was a hard day for us all.

Friday, June 3 Wea.: hot

Some of the neighbors came and helped us finish putting up the rafters on the barn. I got my freight from Highlands yesterday. It has been a hot day.

Saturday, June 4 Wea.: hot

I worked at various jobs today. Pa went out to Hamburg this forenoon. We found a few ripe strawberries this afternoon.

Sunday, June 5 Wea.: hot

Kate and I took the baby and went over to father Queal's to dinner. Mr. and Mrs. Stark of Hamburg were over here. Willie and I made currant ice.

Monday, June 6 Ther.: 90+ Wea.: hot

I took chairs and tables of the Farmers Club over to the Parsonage this morning. Uncle John and aunt Ann came down and spent the day.

Tuesday, June 7 Ther.: 90+

Sprayed some plum trees this morning. Pa and I went to the woods and got some long poles for staying at the barn. We had strawberries for supper. The minister was married today.

Wednesday, June 8
Wea.: hot

I did some work on photography today, retouching and printing on negatives I made at Highlands. We had a little shower at noon, but not enough.

Thursday, June 9

I went to Dexter on the wheel this forenoon to see the doctor about the baby. He is not doing well. I printed on photos this afternoon.

Friday, June 10 Wea.: rain

I printed photos this forenoon and finished up a batch this afternoon. There came up a heavy thunder shower at supper time and broke the drouth. Dewey has been better today.

Saturday, June 11

Did up photos for mailing this forenoon. This afternoon I went to Ann Arbor. Brought Lizzie and Marion home with me. More rain.

Sunday, June 12

Spent the day I resting and snoozing. It was very warm. Little Dewey seems to be sick with something about all the time.

Monday, June 13

It rained hard this morning while we were picking Will's first bushel of strawberries. He sent them to Detroit. Another heavy shower this afternoon.

Tuesday, June 14

Willie shipped 3 crates of berries this morning. I spread straw this forenoon and pa began plowing summer fallow. Rain today noon.

Wednesday, June 15

Picked some strawberries today. Took Kate for a ride this afternoon. It has turned cooler.

Thursday, June 16

Picked berries and spread straw this forenoon. Went to Ann Arbor this afternoon. We have had to begin feeding poor little Dewey on a bottle.

Friday, June 17

Cultivated corn this forenoon. Kate went to see the doctor about Dewey. Picked a lot of strawberries this afternoon.

Saturday, June 18

Pa went to Whitmore Lake for lumber this forenoon. I did some more cultivating. Picked berries this afternoon. Took some to Ed. Ball's folks. Dewey pretty sick all last night.

Sunday, June 19

This was childrens day at the church and I went in the choir to help them sing. Dewey has seemed pretty well today.

Monday, June 20

Cultivated corn today. It grew decidedly cool this evening. Mr. Sharpy painted the barn wall.

Tuesday, June 21

Finished cultivating corn this morning and went to picking strawberries. Got a bushel for canning.

Wednesday, June 22

I printed photos this forenoon. This afternoon I mowed some grass down to commence the haying. We put on the barn doors this noon.

Thursday, June 23

Went at cultivating corn again this morning. A track was put in the peak of the barn for a hay and grain carrier.

Friday, June 24

I cultivated corn part of the forenoon. Raked up the hay this afternoon and cocked some of it up. It has been very hot and I am losing my appetite. Kate and Vida went to Dexter tonight.

Saturday, June 25

Cousin Lizzie went back to Ann Arbor this forenoon. We had a rain last night and this morning and wet all our hay. We fixed a barn bridge. Mr. Calkins of A.A. called this afternoon.

Sunday, June 26

Spent most of the forenoon in a sound sleep. Kate and I took a ride this afternoon and called on her folks.

Monday, June 27

Worked in the garden some this forenoon. We had several showers. Made a large stand for my burnisher. Worked in the hay this afternoon, and went to Delhi.

Tuesday, June 28

Drew hay this forenoon for the cow shed. This afternoon I picked berries and Will worked in the hay. They put several loads in the new barn with the slings.

Wednesday, June 29

Worked at haying most all day. It is very hot now and it takes the tuck out of me. We had a freezer of strawberry sherbet tonight.

Thursday, June 30

Ther.: 90+

Hotter! Worked at haying all day. The tinners came and put the conductors on the new barn. We put in 10 loads of hay.

Friday, July 1 Ther.: 96+

Awful hot. We finished drawing the hay from the field that was cut. I almost gave out with the heat. Nettie West came from Ann Arbor to stay awhile.

Saturday, July 2 Ther.: 95+

Finished some photos this afternoon. Willie went to Ann Arbor and Pa to Dexter this forenoon. Picked

Sunday, July 3

Read and dozed the day away mostly. The strawberries are beginning to get some what scarce. News of a big battle in Cuba are coming in.

Monday, July 4

This has been a cool and beautiful day. Will and Vida were away to a picnic all the afternoon. Pa mowed a lot of grass in the south field.

Tuesday, July 5

Cousin Lizzie went back to Ann Arbor on the train this afternoon. Will Burnett began work here at noon. We hauled considerable hay. I mowed some this evening.

Wednesday, July 6

It has been a nice day for haying, there being a cool breeze.

Thursday, July 7 Ther.: 92+

Getting hot again. Worked in the hay all day.

Friday, July 8

Went to Ann Arbor this forenoon to get binding twine. It was a hot ride. It sprinkled a little after dinner. Mr. Dolbee finished painting the barn and went home.

Saturday, July 9

Cool breeze from north all day. Willie cut wheat. Will Burnett and I drew hay. We set up the wheat late this afternoon. Had an orange sherbet tonight.

Sunday, July 10

Very cool for summer today. I slept a good share of the day. Geo. Martin called a few minutes this afternoon. It grew warmer toward night.

Monday, July 11
